ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on the joint motion of Plaintiff and Defendant Ronald K. Replogle, in his official capacity as Superintendent of the Missouri State Highway Patrol. Plaintiff and Defendant Replogle, having stipulated and consented to the relief set forth below,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Replogle, his successors, officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons under their supervision, or within their control, are permanently enjoined from enforcing a policy or custom of interfering with individuals who are photographing or recording at public places but who are not threatening the safety of others or physically interfering with the ability of law enforcement to perform their duties;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order resolves all claims asserted by Plaintiff in the First Amended Complaint against Defendant Replogle and, thus, he is terminated from this case.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this Court retains jurisdiction to enforce this order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant the City of Ferguson, Missouri, its officers, employees, or agents, and those acting on its behalf, shall not enforce or threaten to enforce any rule, policy, or practice that grants law enforcement officers the authority or discretion to arrest, threaten to arrest, or interfere with any individual, including any member of the media or member of the public photographing or recording in public places unless that person is threatening the safety of others or physically interfering with the ability of law enforcement to perform their duties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order grants the full extent of relief to be afforded Plaintiff herein against the City of Ferguson, and any and all other claims set forth in Plaintiff's Amended Complaint against the City of Ferguson are hereby dismissed.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that this Court retains jurisdiction to enforce this order.
