### **PRESS CONFERENCE:**

**Wednesday, August 8 at 3 p.m.**

Members of the media are invited to attend a press conference to provide updates for the August 10–12 anniversary weekend on **Wednesday, August 8, 2018 at 3 p.m. at the Virginia State Police Area 18 Office located at 900 Natural Resources Drive, Suite 200; Fontaine Research Park**. This event will be live-streamed on the City's [Facebook](#), [Twitter](#), and [Boxcast](#) channels.

Local and state agencies will provide an overview of public safety plans and the latest advisories in relation to events anticipated and planned to take place on the weekend of August 10-12 in the Greater Charlottesville Region.

Representatives from the City of Charlottesville, Albemarle County, University of Virginia, Virginia State Police, Virginia Department of Emergency Management and Virginia National Guard will be participating in the press conference.

### **MEDIA OPERATIONS AND BRIEFING AREA FOR AUGUST 10–12**

A media operations and briefing area will be located at [Charlottesville High School's Martin Luther King Performing Arts Center \(MLK PAC\) from Friday, August 10 through Sunday, August 12.](#)

All accredited members of the media will have access to available wi-fi, power, bathrooms, tables and chairs inside the MLK PAC during operating hours (see below). SAT truck parking is first come, first served in the designated SAT truck parking location. Overflow parking will be in the Main Parking area (see [map](#)).

The media briefing area inside MLK PAC will be the only location used for official press briefings by joint command staff throughout the August 10–12 weekend. All press briefings will be live-streamed on the City's [Facebook](#), [Twitter](#), and [Boxcast](#) channels.

#### **Access to Media Operations/Briefing Area (Inside PAC):**

Sunday, August 12 from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

**All times contingent on events; however, all media, equipment, and vehicles must vacate the premises by midnight on Sunday, August 12.**

### **DOWNTOWN MALL SECURITY PERIMETER**

- There will be NO designated media staging area inside the perimeter. Media members are expected to remain mobile and refrain from long term stationary reporting which may incite and attract participants.
- There will be NO parking of any media vehicles inside the perimeter or around the perimeter in designated no parking areas.
- Camera stands/tripods, microphone stands, lighting stands/poles, boom mics, or any other item that is used to hold or secure camera or sound equipment is prohibited within the established perimeter.
- Backpacks and other large bags are discouraged, and may be subject to search. Any bags or backpacks that are cleared to accompany you inside the perimeter are to remain under your immediate control at all times.
- Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV or aka "drones") will be prohibited within and above the security perimeter. Outside the perimeter, media UAV operators must not interact or interfere with law enforcement aircraft and must follow [FAA guidelines under Part-107.](#)
