ORDER

The Motions to Dismiss and Alternative Motions for Summary Disposition of Governor Mary Fallin and Commissioner Michael Thompson (collectively, "Defendants' Motions to Dismiss") and the Motion for Summary Judgment or, in the alternative, Summary Disposition of Issues of Plaintiffs Ziva Branstetter and BH Media Group Inc. d/b/a Tulsa World ("Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment") filed in the above-captioned case came on for hearing before this Court on April 10, 2015.

The Court, having fully considered the papers submitted in support of and in opposition to Defendants' Motions to Dismiss and Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment, and the oral argument presented by counsel at the hearing thereon, hereby orders, adjudges, and decrees as follows:


1. Defendants' Motions to Dismiss are **DENIED** as to Plaintiffs' Second Cause of Action for Violation of the Oklahoma Open Records Act.
2. Plaintiffs have stipulated to the voluntary dismissal, without prejudice, of their First Cause of Action for Violation of the Oklahoma Constitution. Accordingly, the Court

deems Defendants' Motions to Dismiss moot as to Plaintiffs' First Cause of Action for Violation of the Oklahoma Constitution.

3. Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment is **DENIED** without prejudice.


4. On or before May 11, 2015, the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety ("DPS") shall produce to Plaintiffs a privilege log or index setting forth the specific privilege(s) and/or other legal grounds asserted by DPS as the basis for the redactions made to the documents produced to Plaintiffs on March 13, 2015. Said privilege log or index shall be sufficiently specific to permit Plaintiffs and the Court to evaluate the propriety of those redactions, including any claim of privilege asserted by DPS.

IT IS SO ORDERED this 20th day of April, 2015.




