**ORDER ON PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR *IN CAMERA* REVIEW AND TO COMPEL
THE DISCLOSURE OF RECORDS IMPROPERLY WITHHELD IN WHOLE OR IN
PART IN RESPONSE TO PLAINTIFFS' OPEN RECORDS ACT REQUESTS**

This matter comes before the Court on December 9, 2016 for a hearing on the plaintiffs' motion for *in camera* review and to compel the disclosure of records improperly withheld in whole or in part in response to Plaintiffs' Open Records Act Requests ("Motion").

Upon review of the briefs, and hearing argument by counsel for plaintiffs, the Department of Public Safety ("DPS") and the Office of the Governor Mary Fallin ("Fallin" or the "Governor"), the Court rules as follows:

Plaintiffs' motion for *in camera* review is GRANTED.

By December 29, 2016, the Governor's Office shall lodge with the Court for *in camera* review complete, unredacted versions of all records referred to in Exhibit B to Plaintiffs' Motion.

By December 29, 2016, DPS shall lodge with the Court for *in camera* review complete, unredacted versions of all records referred to in Appendix A and Exhibit D to Plaintiffs' Motion.


By December 29, 2016, Plaintiffs shall furnish the Court with the redacted versions of all records referred to in Appendix A, and Exhibits B and D to their Motion. In order to facilitate the

Court's *in camera* review, Plaintiffs shall notate or otherwise indicate on the redacted versions the specific redactions to which they object.

The Court will issue its final ruling on Plaintiffs' motion to compel the disclosure of records withheld in whole or in part in response to Plaintiffs' ORA requests following its *in camera* review.


With respect to the redacted records identified in Appendix A to Plaintiffs' Motion, counsel for DPS is ordered to give prompt notice to the Attorney General of the State of Oklahoma (the "AG") and the Oklahoma Department of Corrections ("DOC") that they are required to file with the Court any objection to the release of the information identified in Appendix A to Plaintiffs' Motion, and the basis for any such objection, on or before December 29, 2016. In the event neither the AG nor the DOC file a timely objection to the release of that information, DPS is ordered immediately to release to Plaintiffs the information identified in Appendix A to Plaintiffs' Motion.

IT IS SO ORDERED this 26th of December 2016.






