**SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE OF THE UNITED STATES TO
APPLICATION FOR ACCESS TO CERTAIN SEALED COURT RECORDS**

The United States of America, by its attorneys, Dana J. Boente, United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Virginia, and W. Neil Hammerstrom, Jr., Assistant United States Attorney, hereby files this Supplemental Response to the Application of Reporters Committee for Freedom of the Press (hereafter “Reporters Committee”) seeking unsealing of certain documents and records filed by the government in connection with the investigation and prosecution of the matter styled as *U.S. v. John C. Kiriakou*, Criminal No. 1:12-cr-00127.

Specifically, the Reporters Committee seeks:

- (a) Search warrant materials;
- (b) Pen Register/Trap and Trace materials; and
- (c) 18 U.S.C. § 2703(d) orders

Following a diligent search of the government’s files in this case, only one item has been identified as having been filed in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia (EDVA) that is responsive to the Reporters Committee’s application and over which this Court has jurisdiction to unseal, and that is a search warrant, the application for that warrant, the

affidavit in support of the application for said warrant, and the sealing motion and order (collectively, the “Search Warrant Materials”), designated by EDVA docket number 1:12-sw-38.

Accordingly, the United States herewith files the attached, redacted Search Warrant Materials, which were unsealed by this Court on February 17, 2017, upon motion of the government. The redactions consist of personal identifying information and were made as required by Local Criminal Rule 49(B) of this Court. *See* Search Warrant Materials and Unsealing Order, attached.
