This access does not extend to the exhibits that were sealed pursuant to the Counter Order to Impound and Seal Defendant's Exhibits entered January 24, 2019.

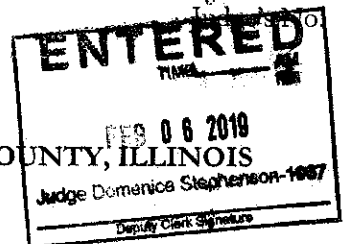
