

**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 20<sup>th</sup> day of Dec., 2021, after consideration of the parties' positions during oral argument on December 16, 2021, it is hereby ordered that:

- (1) *The Altoona Mirror's* Motion to Intervene is **GRANTED**;
- (2) *The Altoona Mirror's* Motion to Unseal is **GRANTED**. The Prothonotary of Blair County is directed to unseal the above-captioned matter and permit public access and inspection;
- (3) The parties shall adhere to the Case Records Public Access Policy of the Unified Judicial System of Pennsylvania and pursuant to Sections 7.0 (Confidential Information) and 8.0 (Confidential documents), any documents related to minors' names and dates of birth, minors' educational records or medical/psychological records shall be filed with a court or custodian under a cover sheet designated "Confidential Document Form."
- (4) Pursuant to representations made by counsel for *The Altoona Mirror* during oral argument, Plaintiff parent/children's names shall not be publicly identified, unless they provide consent or upon further order of court.
