GENERAL JUDGMENT

THIS MATTER came for hearing on Plaintiff’s Motion for Summary Judgment on August 11, 2023, before the Honorable Beth Bagley. Plaintiff Avion Water Company (“Avion”) was represented by its counsel, C. Robert Steringer. Defendant Source Weekly was represented by its counsel, Steven Wilker. After hearing argument and reviewing submissions by counsel, the Court granted all motions included in Plaintiff’s Motion for Summary Judgment.

IT IS ORDERED and ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The Court declares that Avion is neither a “public body” nor the functional equivalent of a public body under Oregon’s Public Records Law, ORS chapter 192.

2. Defendant is enjoined from enforcing the Deschutes County District Attorney’s order requiring Avion to produce records to defendant.


