

which the Court made a determination that sealing the arrest warrant as requested, served a compelling state interest in maintaining the integrity and confidentiality of the Commonwealth's ongoing investigation. This Court made a determination that denying the Commonwealth's motion to invoke Pa R.C.P. 513.1 would significantly compromise the ongoing investigation and community safety.

As the Commonwealth's investigation continues to develop, this Court is of the opinion that the arrest warrant information shall remain under seal until further Order of Court, as to unseal the warrant information at this time would compromise the integrity of the ongoing investigation.

In light of the foregoing, the Court enters the following Order:
