## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

On November 5, 2022 at 1920 hours, the Rostraver Township Police Department was dispatched to the Rostraver Square Shopping Plaza located at 203 Sara Way, Rostraver Twp., PA for a report of shots fired and a victim down in the parking area. Initial responding officers and emergency medical personnel responded and identified the victim, Boyke Budiachman, sustained a gunshot wound to the head. Budiachman was subsequently pronounced dead at the scene.

On November 6, 2022 at 1350 hours, your affiants interviewed the defendant, Keven Lam, in reference to this investigation. Lam advised that he and the victim are friends/business associates related to a temporary staffing agency that Lam purchased from the victim in 2019. Lam stated that following the purchase of the business, the victim took employees from Lam and employed them through a competitive staffing agency. Lam stated that for the previous two years, he's confronted the victim about taking his employees and the related loss of income caused by these actions. Lam stated that when the victim continued to take his employees/revenue after being warned on several occasions, Lam consulted with a Vietnamese individual known to him to engage in criminal activity. Lam identified this individual by the first name "Tuan" who resides in South Philadelphia. Lam stated that approximately a month ago, he and "Tuan" agreed upon a price of \$65,000.00 for "Tuan" to take care of the victim. Lam stated that on November 3, 2022, he contacted "Tuan" and notified him that Lam and the victim would be having dinner at the Samurai Japanese restaurant in Rostraver Township on November 5, 2022 at 1830 hours. Lam further stated that when he and the victim arrived at the restaurant he notified "Tuan" of their location. Lam stated that when he and the victim were preparing the exit the restaurant he again phoned "Tuan" to notify him of their exit.

Surveillance video within the plaza shows Lam and the victim exit the restaurant and approach their respective vehicles. Lam enters his Toyota Tundra truck and drives from the scene. As the victim opens the driver's side door of his vehicle, an unknown masked actor approaches him from the rear and shoots the victim in the head and flees the scene.

Following the incident, Lam advised your affiants that he drove to an area of Philadelphia where he placed \$65,000.00 in a duffle bag in a previously agreed upon location for "Tuan" to retrieve. Lam stated that during the early morning hours of November 6, 2022, he received telephone correspondence from "Tuan" that he took possession of the duffle bag/currency. Lam advised your affiants that he disposed of the cellular telephone that he used to correspond with "Tuan" to conceal it and its digital contents from law enforcement.

Charges filed based on information received through investigation that your affiants believe to be true and correct to the best of their ability.
