Thank you for your request for records made in accordance with the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (§ 2.2-3700 et seq.). You requested records relating to Taser logs or any documentation of taser use at Red Onion State Prison from Jan. 1, 2025 to the present day.

Please be advised the Virginia Department of Corrections (VADOC) has approximately 60 pages of records from three incidents responsive to your request. However, pursuant to § 2.2.-3706(B)(4) of the Code of Virginia, the records requested are exempt from mandatory disclosure as “records of persons imprisoned in penal institutions in the Commonwealth provided such records relate to the imprisonment.” Accordingly, the VADOC is exercising its discretion to withhold these records in their entirety.
