**TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**

This matter comes before this Court on Motion for a temporary restraining order filed by Petitioner Tommie Rae Brown. Rule 65, SCRCF allows this Court to issue a temporary restraining order so long as it provides the restrained party with an immediate right to be heard within ten (10) days. 
